Why perform community service?

All upper school students must complete <u>30 hours of service per year</u>. Students may arrange their own projects and/or participate in those offered through the school. Any student who transfers in from another institution will be held to the same service hour requirement each year until graduation. Opportunities for service are communicated and available through a student's Naviance account. To be eligible for graduation, seniors must complete a **minimum of 120 community service hours by the first Friday in May.**

Service Hour Guidelines for Students:

- 1. **IDENTIFY** an area of interest or social problem that you are passionate about serving and leading.
- 2. **OBTAIN** prior approval from his/her school counselor or Seminar teacher to ensure that the community service site meets the criteria and that the student will receive community service hours for volunteering.
 - 3. **LEAD** in service and obtain at least 30 hours of community service per year. Seminar teachers will be checking in and verifying hours each Quarter and Semester.
 - 4. **DOCUMENT**: Obtain documentation of service hours from the site supervisor on agency letterhead, of student hours, dates of service and service activities. All documentation can be uploaded through this google form.
 - All service hour forms must be accompanied by a letter confirming the fact that these service hours were completed AND it must be on a letterhead from that organization.
 - All paid work hours must be verified by your work site supervisor/manager through the Paid Work Experience form and a written letter

- Serving at a not-for-profit organization or event, example: Hurricane Relief, Beverly's Angels, etc.
- Animal rescues and shelters, such as Naples Humane Society
- Hospital volunteers, NCH, Lee Health, Etc.
- Quest tutoring/mentoring programs
- Holiday related projects such as Toys-for-Tots, Angel Tree, Shoe Box Ministry etc.

- An activity where there is no responsible adult on site to evaluate and confirm student performance.
- Donations, such as Locks of Love or giving blood.
- Participation on a sports team or a performance of any kind unless participation is considered an act of service.
- Any hours verified by another TVS student.
